Establishing and Maintaining an Industrial Collaboration

Start-up:

- Industry may contact you
- Industrial Problem Solving Workshops
- Institute Contacts
- Former students in industry

Continuation:

- Maintain close ties with personal contact in the company
- Be aware of intellectual property and time concerns
- Work towards industrially useful problems with mathematical interest
- Avoid situations where collaboration is essential
