Top Ten (95% Credible Interval: Eight to Eleven) Things Public and Population Health Researchers Might Need and Want from Statisticians

A current trend occurring in many health research disciplines is a growing requirement for explicit activities devoted towards "knowledge transfer". Workshops such as this one provide evidence that that trend may be influencing other disciplines, including statistics. Knowledge transfer begins with dialogue to understand what "receptors" require.
